



DOCTRA xECM Attribute Extensions for OpenText Content Server

Summary

The OpenText Content Server offers a wealth of document management functionality that already goes beyond what can be expected from a modern ECM system. On top of that Doctra offers add-on packages which make working with the OpenText Content Server even more efficient and flexible.

These Add-Ons are developed and maintained by Doctra – driven by frequent customer requests.

Doctra Extensions for the OpenText Content Server provide you with pre-packaged solutions that are developed and tested by experienced Content Server specialists. The modules are available for different Content Server versions with language packs for German (DE) and English (EN).

The Add-Ons are offered as license packages including maintenance, making them future-proof and ready for upcoming OpenText Content Server versions.

DOCTRA xECM Attribute Extensions

OpenText "Extended ECM for SAP Solutions" is a comprehensive package that enables extended ECM functions to be used directly from within the SAP system. Such an integrated system is very convenient for SAP users - and via the web-based user interface, the system is also available to non-SAP users. The standard version, however, lacks the possibility to interactively access SAP data directly from the Content Server Web Interface "in the opposite direction" when indexing documents with attribute values.

Doctra xECM Attribute Extensions now allow Content Server users to directly access SAP data in the attribute creation for categories. The xECM Attribute Extensions make it much easier to e.g. create suppliers on the Content Server side because the SAP master record data can directly be transferred from SAP to the Content Server. This significantly reduces the effort required for data entry and minimizes the risk of incorrect entries.

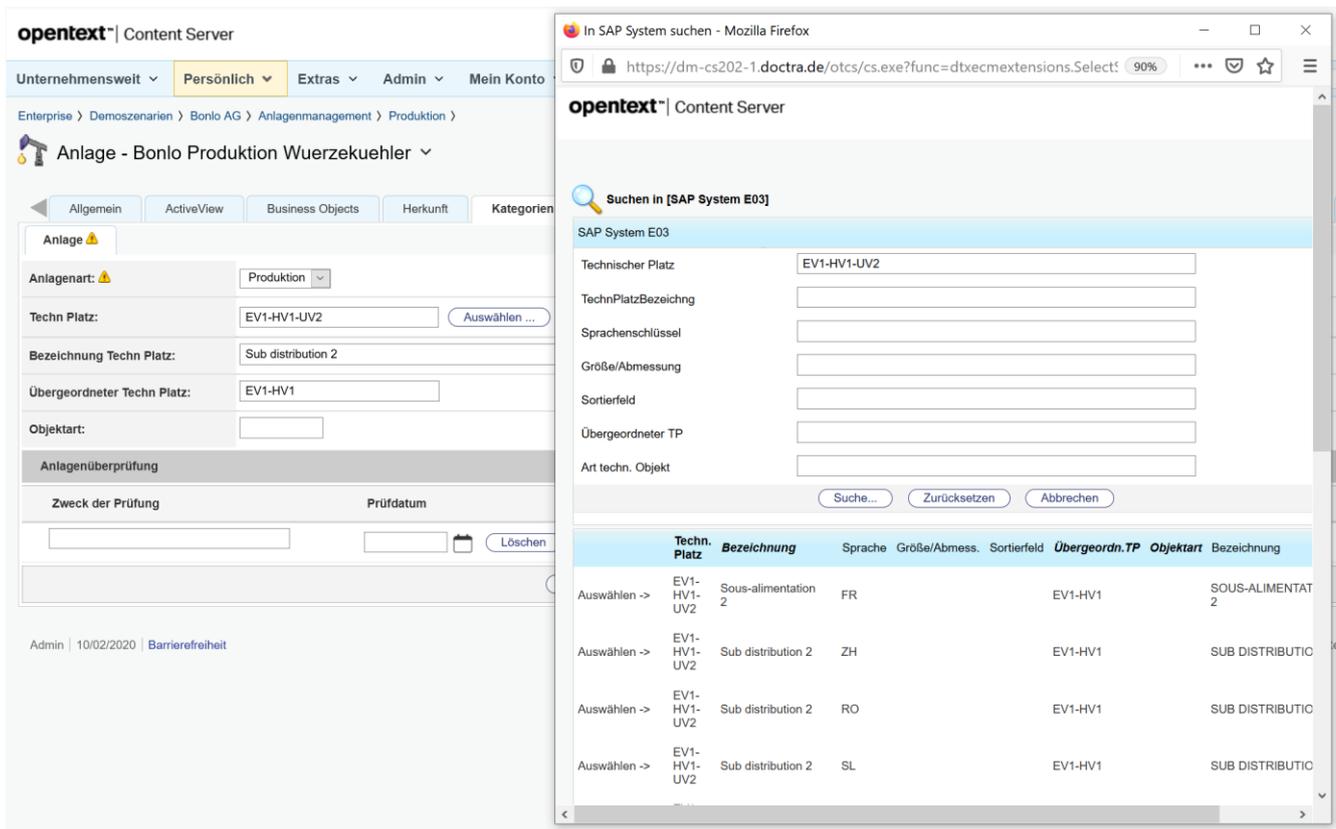
The xECM Attribute Extensions offers

- a new attribute type for SAP data
- flexible attribute mapping also for multiple attributes / related attributes
- usable within any category
- almost any SAP data can be integrated, independent of any workspace definitions
- ready-to-use interface for easy attribute transfer from SAP

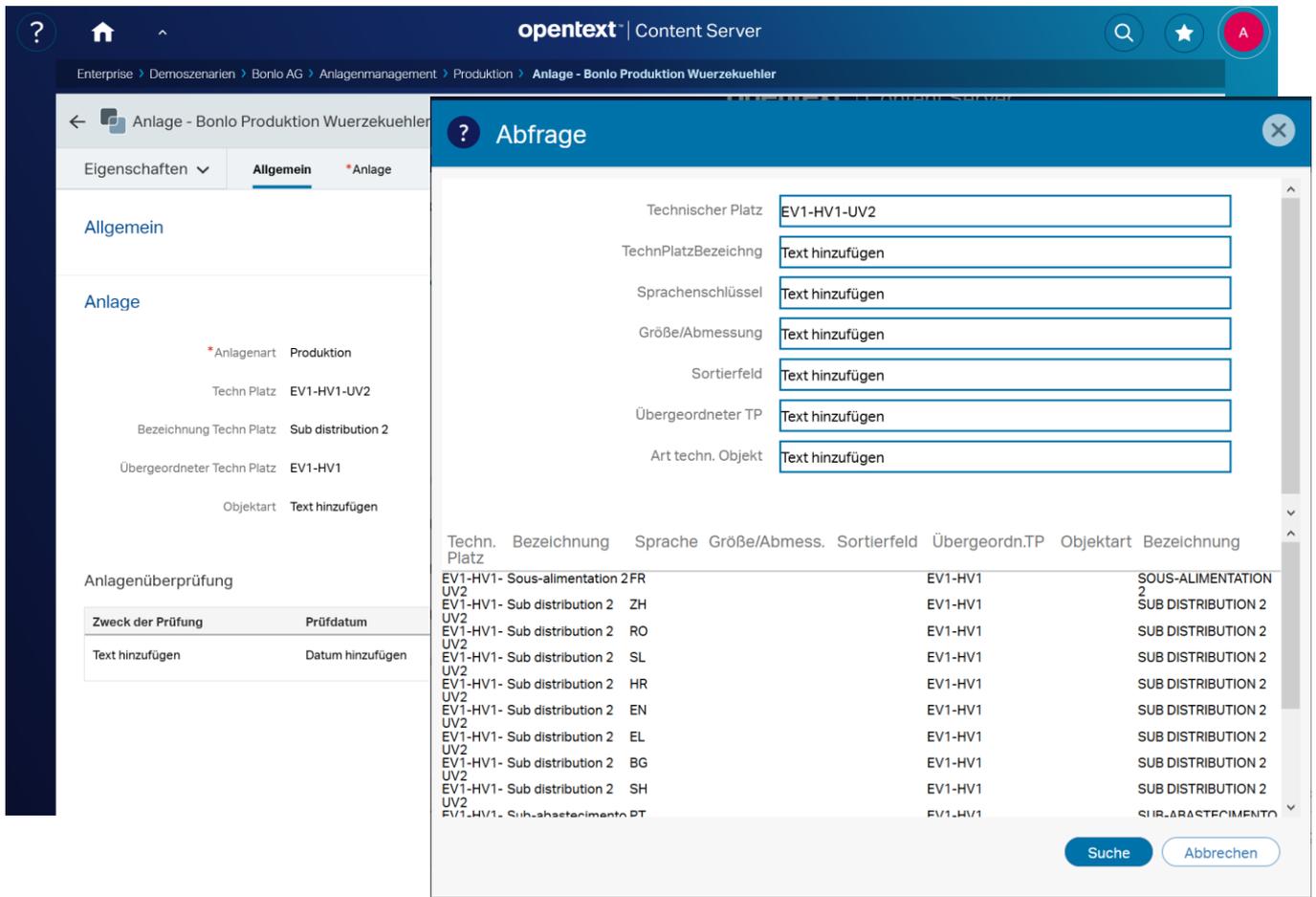
There are almost no limits regarding the flexibility of the application. The search help function of SAP is used for the attribute selection in Content Server and thus the existing SAP functionality can be used directly in the Content Server.

Examples for using attribute extensions:

- assigning a contract partner, which is maintained in SAP, to a contract file
- assigning a cost center to a BANF
- assigning a debtor for a quotation document
- creating a supplier master in the Content Server based on SAP data
- creating an attachment and assigning/transferring a functional location in SAP
